U.S. EXPORT SALES FOR WEEKENDING 4/20/2017

Cotton: Net upland sales of 115,500 RB for 2016/2017 were down 49 percent from the previous week and 61 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were reported for Vietnam (51,400 RB, including 3,500 RB switched from China, 2,200 RB switched from Taiwan, 1,000 RB switched from South Korea, and 200 RB switched from Japan and decreases of 700 RB), Turkey (33,200 RB, including decreases of 3,800 RB), Indonesia (15,700 RB, including 300 RB switched from Japan and decreases of 800 RB), India (7,400 RB, including decreases of 4,500 RB), and Malaysia (5,400 RB, including 100 RB switched from Japan and decreases of 2,700 RB). Reductions were reported for South Korea (9,000 RB), Japan (1,900 RB), and China (1,900 RB). For 2017/2018, net sales of 65,300 RB were reported primarily for South Korea (15,000 RB), Vietnam (12,900 RB), and Pakistan (12,300 RB). Exports of 302,400 RB were down 16 percent from the previous week and 26 percent from the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were Vietnam (45,900 RB), Turkey (43,400 RB), India (38,500 RB), Indonesia (31,700 RB), and China (23,900 RB). Net sales of Pima totaling 5,900 RB for 2016/2017 were down 45 percent from the previous week and 48 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were primarily for China (2,700 RB), India (2,000 RB), Japan (600 RB), and Thailand (300 RB). Reductions were reported for Germany (300 RB). For 2017/2018, net sales of 7,500 RB were reported for China (3,900 RB), India (1,800 RB), Austria (900 RB), and Pakistan (900 RB). Exports of 15,500 RB were up 82 percent from the previous week and 18 percent from the prior 4-week average. The destinations were primarily India (6,000 RB), China (4,000 RB), Vietnam (2,200 RB), Portugal (1,000 RB), Pakistan (700 RB), and South Korea (500 RB).

Exports for Own Account: For 2016/2017, new exports for own account were reported to Vietnam (500 RB). Exports to Indonesia (7,300 RB) and Vietnam (1,900 RB) were applied to new or outstanding sales. The current outstanding balance of 99,300 RB is for Indonesia (51,500 RB), China (24,300 RB), Taiwan (11,900 RB), Vietnam (2,800 RB), South Korea (2,600 RB), Bangladesh (2,500 RB), Thailand (1,900 RB), India (1,300 RB), and Pakistan (500 RB).
