U.S. EXPORT SALES FOR WEEKENDING 5/11/2017

Cotton: Net upland sales of 120,700 RB for 2016/2017 were down 25 percent from the previous week and 26 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were reported for Vietnam (51,600 RB, including 8,800 RB switched from Japan and 4,400 RB switched from China), Turkey (51,300 RB), Indonesia (13,000 RB, including 1,600 RB switched from Japan), Thailand (12,400 RB, including 100 RB switched from Japan), and China (8,800 RB). Reductions were reported for India (23,300 RB) and Japan (12,800 RB). For 2017/2018, net sales of 165,100 RB were reported primarily for China (66,400 RB), Vietnam (32,200 RB), Bangladesh (25,100 RB), and Taiwan (7,900 RB). Exports of 388,000 RB were down 6 percent from the previous week, but up 9 percent from the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were Vietnam (67,900 RB), India (53,800 RB), China (48,900 RB), Turkey (48,300 RB), and Indonesia (32,300 RB). Net sales of Pima totaling 6,500 RB for 2016/2017 were up 95 percent from the previous week and 21 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were primarily for China (5,100 RB), India (500 RB), Egypt (400 RB), and Turkey (300 RB). For 2017/2018, net sales of 5,400 RB were reported for China (4,400 RB), Germany (900 RB), and Japan (100 RB). Exports of 11,300 RB were down 28 percent from the previous week and 22 percent from the prior 4-week average. The destinations were primarily India (4,400 RB), China (1,900 RB), Pakistan (1,600 RB), and Vietnam (1,300 RB).

Exports for Own Account: New exports for own account were reported to Vietnam (5,200 RB), Bangladesh (4,600 RB), Turkey (2,200 RB), India (2,200 RB), Malaysia (1,900 RB), Indonesia (1,400 RB), South Korea (1,200 RB), China (500 RB), and Thailand (300 RB). Exports to China (5,200 RB), India (3,000 RB), and Vietnam (2,700 RB) were applied to new or outstanding sales. Decreases were reported to Indonesia (500 RB). The current outstanding balance of 111,500 RB is for Indonesia (52,800 RB), China (19,600 RB), Taiwan (14,100 RB), Bangladesh (7,200 RB), Vietnam (6,000 RB), South Korea (4,500 RB), Thailand (2,200 RB), Turkey (2,200 RB), Malaysia (1,900 RB), Pakistan (500 RB), and India (500 RB).
