U.S. EXPORT SALES FOR WEEKENDING 5/25/2017

Cotton: Net upland sales of 110,900 RB for 2016/2017 were up noticeably from the previous week, but down 1 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were reported for Vietnam (34,700 RB, including 7,000 RB switched from Japan, 2,400 RB switched from India, 1,900 RB switched from South Korea, 1,300 RB switched from Bangladesh, and 900 RB switched from Taiwan), China (34,600 RB), Turkey (13,400 RB, including decreases of 200 RB), Indonesia (9,700 RB, including 300 RB switched from Japan and decreases of 100 RB), and Thailand (7,600 RB, including decreases of 400 RB). Reductions were reported for Japan (6,600 RB), Brazil (2,400 RB), and Taiwan (2,200 RB). For 2017/2018, net sales of 159,600 RB reported primarily for Turkey (38,600 RB), Vietnam (36,000 RB), and China (31,700 RB), were partially offset by reductions for Taiwan (100 RB). Exports of 370,400 RB were up 11 percent from the previous week, but down 1 percent from the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were Turkey (85,600 RB), Vietnam (57,600 RB), Bangladesh (43,000 RB), China (42,800 RB), and India (37,400 RB). Net sales reductions of Pima totaling 2,800 RB for 2016/2017--a marketing-year low--were down noticeably from the previous week and from the prior 4-week average. Increases for China (400 RB), Bangladesh (300 RB), and Thailand (200 RB, switched from Japan), were more than offset by reductions for Germany (2,200 RB), Italy (1,300 RB), and Japan (200 RB). For 2017/2018, net sales of 10,000 RB were reported for Germany (4,400 RB), China (4,300 RB), and Italy (1,300 RB). Exports of 10,700 RB were down 18 percent from the previous week and 26 percent from the prior 4-week average. The destinations were primarily India (5,600 RB), China (3,500 RB), South Korea (500 RB), and Japan (400 RB).

Exports for Own Account: New exports for own account were reported to Indonesia (4,400 RB), Vietnam (2,600 RB), China (2,200 RB), Taiwan (2,200 RB), India (1,600 RB), and South Korea (1,300 RB). Exports to China (26,000 RB) and Vietnam (2,400 RB) were applied to new or outstanding sales. The current outstanding balance of 103,600 RB is for Indonesia (62,000 RB), Taiwan (16,300 RB), Bangladesh (7,200 RB), India (5,800 RB), South Korea (5,400 RB), Vietnam (4,500 RB), Thailand (1,900 RB), and Pakistan (500 RB).
